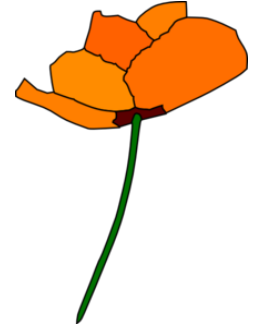


Yerba Buena Nursery Lawn “Removal” Basic Steps



1. Remove unwanted shrubs/trees
2. Cap off existing sprinkler system underground
3. *Optional*: “Scalp” lawn – mow as low as possible
4. Cut back edges of lawn, 4” deep and 12” in from edge
5. Create organic looking mounds with removed soil
6. Place two layers of uncoated brown sheet mulching paper¹ at right angles over the entire lawn
7. Place 4-6” layer of soil² over paper
8. Install plants (see transplanting instructions)³
9. *If Applicable*: Install drip lines
10. Mulch with 3” layer of wood chips⁴ or leaves

1: Uncoated brown sheet mulching paper is available at Lyngso Garden Materials in San Carlos. \$14.50 for a 35” x 166’ roll.

2: Lyngso Garden Materials carries an excellent mix for natives under the name ‘potting mix’. It is fast draining and not too rich for native species.
